

# Candidate Disclosure Form

This form must be completed by a nominee for public office. The information in this disclosure will be disclosed to the Candidate Review Committee. If a candidate is in any doubt as to the relevance of a matter, they should err on the side of disclosure. A nominee for public office will be afforded the opportunity to explain the circumstances surrounding any disclosure. Where a nominee requires additional space to provide details about any matter, they should attach additional pages and indicate that they have done so on this form.

The onus is on the candidate to fulfil the requirement of this form. If the candidate is unclear of the information sought or how to undertake the steps outlined (e.g. the deactivation of social media accounts), the onus is on the candidate to obtain advice.

**Candidates must disclose any matter that may be potentially relevant to their endorsement to stand for preselection. All questions must be answered – your nomination will be rejected if any question is left unanswered. A failure to fully disclose any relevant matter is grounds for immediate rejection.**
